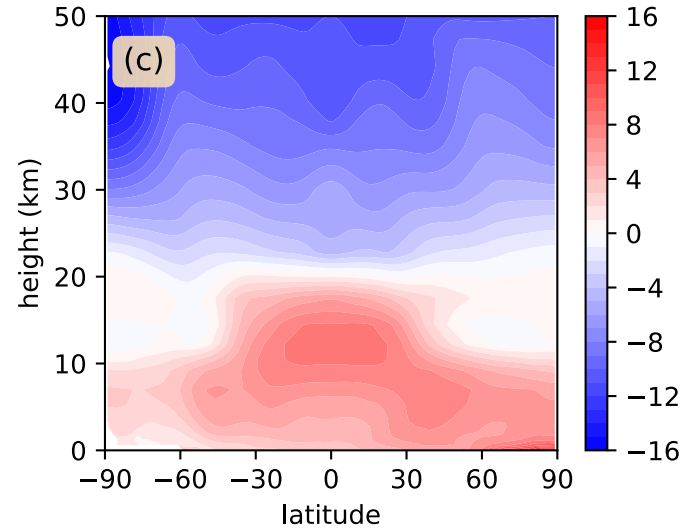


Example of a good slide: A descriptive title

(A descriptive title would fit this slide, but no other)

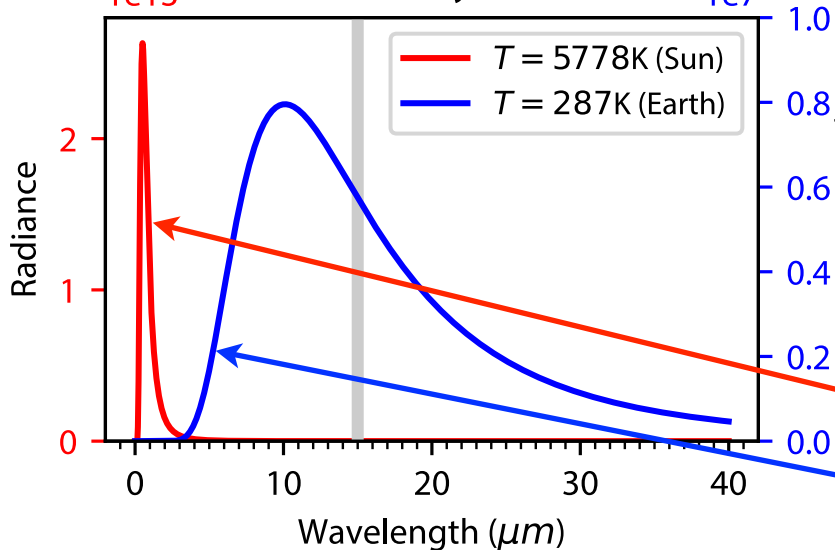
Minimize the use of schematics; use scientific graphics. Add a caption for each figure, explaining briefly what is shown, including both axes and all lines, etc.



Avoid slides that are too dense, or too sparse. Use a couple of images plus some text per slide.

The red line indicates this, while the blue shows that.
