If you are concerned for your safety, call the HUPD at 617.495.1212 (Cambridge) or 617.432.1212 (Longwood). For medical emergencies, call 911.

The hotline operates 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and is run by an independent, third-party provider. It is meant for reporting of issues in situations where you don't feel comfortable speaking with a supervisor or other resource. Any concerns may be raised through the hotline, including but not limited to:

Fraud/theft

Accounting irregularities

Misuse of University  
resources/assets

Regulatory compliance

Violation of law, contract,  
or Harvard policy

Conflicts of interest

Bias-related incidents<sup>1</sup>

Environmental health and  
safety concerns

International medical, safety,
